The Old Mission Inn features 13 rooms (combination of suites and studio), 11 baths, multiple dining rooms/bar area, 1300 sq ft covered porch overlooking the bay and a large commercial kitchen. This is the longest continual running hotel in Michigan and has been accurately restored to it's original use and condition, including the original Old Mission Post office and switch board room/equipment. Famous guests include Babe Ruth and Joe Louis, with their guest registry on display.

Although currently operated as a profitable hotel, the owners have a full service liquor license (allows for package sales) and approval for serving breakfast, lunch and dinner to the general public, including outdoor seating. There is so much potential for many revenue streams in one of the premiere buildings and locations in the Country!

4 more rooms that are in the process of being fully updated and ready to rent.








Mission Bay Cafe
